- **Ash Wednesday:** Ash Wednesday Masses on Wednesday, February 14th includes:
 - 10:30 am & 7pm – Holy Family Church
 - 3pm – St. Ann’s Church
- **Weekday Mass During Lent:** Weekday Mass at **Holy Family Church on Friday mornings at 10:30am beginning on February 16th**. If it is not possible to have the Mass during a particular week, we will hold a **Stations of the Cross**. (A virtual Stations of the Cross can be found on our website-stkateria.ca. - **Lenten Documentary Series:** St. Kateri Tekakwitha Parish is offering an opportunity to enter into Lenten reflection by support of the **Truth and Reconciliation 94 Calls to Action**. “Recognizing that all Canadians, as treaty peoples, share responsibility in establishing and maintaining respectful relationships”, we will offer a learning and listening opportunity. The first documentary is **Wednesday, February 21st starting at 7pm** at Holy Family Church followed by a second documentary on **Wednesday, February 28th**. All are welcome!
- **Stations of the Cross:** During Lent, Stations of the Cross will be held on the following three **Tuesdays: February 20th, March 5th, and March 19th at 10:30am at Holy Family Church**. We look forward to seeing you!
